CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

DBIA's Design-Build in Transportation Leadership Awards pay tribute to individuals in the transportation industry who have made significant contributions to advance awareness, understanding and use of the design-build project delivery method.

The award(s) will be presented at DBIA's 2018 Transportation Conference held March 21-23 in Portland, Oregon.

Nominations should address leadership in the areas of technical, legislative, organizational, industry-wide or organization-wide actions as well as support for DBIA's Industry Best Practices.

Applications accepted through January 26, 2018.

Who is Eligible? Any owner or practitioner working in the transportation field who has successfully utilized the design-build project delivery method.

DBIA encourages the nomination of individuals who are proficient in the use of design-build and have successfully implemented design-build programs. However, it is not essential that the individual is responsible for a large or long-standing design-build program. Professionals who have provided significant support to the design-build industry while building a new design-build program through encouraged use of DBIA Best Practices are also encouraged to apply.

Who can Nominate? Nominations can be accepted from individuals or companies. In addition, individuals may nominate themselves for this award. Membership in DBIA is not required. DBIA does not require an entry fee for this nomination.
